


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

Absa Group Timeline



The Amalgamated Banks of South Africa (Absa) is created through the unification of United, Allied, and Volkskas Banks and certain Sage interests.

2005 – Barclays PLC acquires a 55,5% stake in Absa.


The majority of Barclays PLC's businesses in Africa are combined with Absa to create Barclays Africa Group Ltd. Barclays PLC's stake in the combined entity is 62,3%.

Barclays PLC starts reducing its 62,3% shareholding in Barclays Africa Group after changes in international regulations following the 2008 global financial crisis made it less attractive to own stakes in large banks abroad.

Barclays PLC reduces its shareholding in Barclays Africa Group to a minority stake of 14,9% and the two companies start separating operations.

Barclays Africa Group is renamed Absa Group Limited. Absa Group continues to be the largest shareholder in Absa and Barclays-branded banks in Africa. The Barclays-branded subsidiaries, among others, are to be rebranded in time.
